

# Masagoya - The Home of Wheat Rope

Limited seasonal opening! Self-serve nagashi-somen



#### Introduction

In the east of Takamatsu City, close to the Kimbuchi Forest Park, there is a nagashi-somen restaurant open only during the summer season. Nagashi-somen is noodles that are slid down a bamboo lane, which you grab with your chopsticks as they flow by. This is one of Japan's seasonal specialties.

"Masagoya – The Home of Wheat Rope" was created by the owner of Masagoya, a local udon and somen restaurant owner and his friends. In the natural setting of a local valley, you can taste Shodoshima's special 'island wheat rope' somen – of course handmade. You first determine the amount of noodles you want to eat, pay for them, and then slide them down the bamboo lane in self-service style. (Advance reservation required for groups.)

This is a unique spot for enjoying nagashi-somen in Kagawa, and will be a lovely memory for the children during their summer break.
